Float Trip

You and your personal effects are transported with canoes and equipment upriver to the Jack Shuger Memorial Park in Moscow, IA. The float back to the Saulsbury Bridge Recreation Area is a relaxing, slow-paced trip. During most of the canoeing season there are plenty of sandbars to stop at and picnic or just relax.

Please Note

- ◆ Rate shown is for one canoe with two passengers.
- ◆ There is an additional \$5.00 charge for a third person in the canoe that we transport to Moscow.
- ◆ No more than three people per canoe.
- ◆ A minimum of three canoes must be going for shuttle to run.
- ◆ Ten canoes are available for rent and we can haul a maximum of 21 people.
- ◆ The cost of the trip includes transportation, canoe, and equipment.
- ◆ Shuttle departs from the Cedar River boat ramp at the Saulsbury Bridge Recreation Area.

General Information

- ◆ We reserve the right to postpone or cancel any trip considered unsafe due to poor weather or high water. **A full refund will be given in this case.**
- ◆ Life vests for children over 30 pounds, and adult sizes up to a 60 inch chest are provided. Life vests for children under 30 pounds or adults with a chest size larger than 60 inches must be provided by the user.
- ◆ Iowa Law requires a life vest for each person in the boat and that children 13 years and younger wear a life jacket at all times.
- ◆ All rental agreements must be signed by an adult.
- ◆ Pets are not allowed.
- ◆ In order to keep operating costs low, you will be required to unload and load your own canoes.
- ◆ Camping is available at the Saulsbury Bridge Recreation Area.

- ◆ **Reservations are required.**
- ◆ **25% non-refundable deposit required with all reservations.**
- ◆ **Deposit must be made within ten days of reservation to secure reservation.**
- ◆ **Remainder of payment due seven days prior to day of float trip.**

To reach the Saulsbury Bridge Recreation Area from I-80

- ◆ Take exit 267 south to Moscow.
- ◆ Continue south on Moscow Road crossing Highway 6.
- ◆ Turn right at the stop sign at County Road F70 (155th St.).
- ◆ Go to the four-way stop and turn left on County Road X54 (N. Mulberry).
- ◆ Go south approximately 1.5 miles and turn right on Saulsbury Road at the County Conservation sign.
- ◆ Follow Saulsbury Road to the park.
- ◆ Once inside the park follow the signs to the Cedar River boat ramp.

To reach the Saulsbury Bridge Recreation Area from Highway 61

- ◆ Take the Mulberry exit north off the Highway 61 By-pass.
- ◆ Go about 2.5 miles and turn left on Saulsbury Road at the County Conservation sign.
- ◆ Follow Saulsbury Road to the park.
- ◆ Once inside the park follow the signs to the Cedar River boat ramp.
